

STATISTICS

- It takes burglars on average 60 seconds to break into a home and less than 10 minutes to finish the job.
- It takes police officers an average of 3 to 15 minutes to respond to an alarm or 911 calls.
- In 1994 over 2 billion dollars worth of merchandise was taken from homes by burglars.
- Average loss to homeowners was \$1296.00
- 35 % of residential burglaries occur at night.
- 64 % of all burglars enter through the front or back door.
- In 20 % of all burglaries the burglar entered through first floor windows.
- Most home and business alarms are not answered locally; they are routed through the company then to the local police department or dispatch center.
- Cutting the power or phone lines can disable a common house or business alarm.
- Over 25 % of crimes are committed by people under 18 years of age.
- 2 out of 3 burglaries are residential
- In 1985, 42 % of those burglaries were without force (meaning the doors or windows were open or unlocked)
- 37% of the no force burglaries occurred between 6am and 6pm.
- 25% of all automobiles are stolen from residential homes.
- 4 out of 5 stolen vehicles were unlocked.
- 2/3 of all women attacked are at the hands of family, friends or someone they knew.

Robbery	one occurs every 51 seconds
Assaults	one occurs every 28 seconds
Burglary	one occurs every 12 seconds
Theft	one occurs every 4 seconds
Auto Theft	one occurs every 20 seconds
